Tsering Nyandak

Biography

Tsering Nyandak was born in Lhasa, Tibet in 1974. Between 1985 and 1993 he lived and studied in Dharamsala, India. Although a largely self-taught artist, he spent a period after his return to Tibet studying under the Tibetan painter Tsewang Tashi. Nyandak's oil and acrylic works are characterized by his keen observations of social phenomena, coupled by the desire to communicate an intuitive emotional reality shorn of preconceived conceptual or intellectual elaboration.
